- Endorsement of amendments to EnvA's Constitution Background:

EnvA recently applied for Deductable Gift Recipient Status which would allow donors to claim any donation as a tax deduction. During this process, we were advised that further information was needed including:

- 1. A copy of an amended Constitution which includes:
 - Provision of a Gift Fund;
 - Policy to not act as a mere conduit for funds to another organisation; and
 - A winding up and revocation clause.
- 2. A dated and signed meeting minutes as proof that the amended Constitution has been formally adopted.
- 3. Provide a list of organisations which recognise the Association as an environmental organisation.

The <u>proposed amendments to EnvA's Constitution</u> are presented in track change on page 14 of the document and are based on the model rules provided by the Australian Tax Office. Aside from numbering of the paragraphs and update of the version number, no other amendments are proposed aside from the required additional clauses.
